



## Threes Daycare Sample Schedule

7-8AM	<b>Classroom Time &amp; Arrival</b>   Greeting children and parents. Health check. Free play in centers. Breakfast snack if child arrives before 8:15AM
8-9AM	<b>Specialized Classes and/or Classroom Time</b>   A balanced mix of activities w/ child-directed Independent Free Play in centers AND teacher-directed activities: One-on-One, in Small and/or Large Group • Art (* Creative Expression, Cognitive, Literacy, etc.)
9-10AM	<b>Playground Time and Bathroom</b>   Outdoor Play or Indoor Movement and Games (* Health & Physical Development)
10-11AM	<b>Classroom Time</b>   A balanced mix of *activities w/ child-directed Independent Free Play in centers, AND teacher-directed activities: One-on-One and in Small Group (* Literacy, Cognitive, Math, Science, Handwriting Without Tears, etc.)
11-11:30AM	<b>Lunch</b>
11:30-12PM	<b>Specialized Classes and/or Classroom Time</b>   A balanced mix of activities w/ child-directed Independent Free Play in centers AND teacher-directed activities: One-on-One, in Small and/or Large Group (* Art, Cognitive, Language & Communication, etc.)
12-12:30PM	<b>Large Group Time</b>   Bible Time, Active Learning through Songs and Music (* Spiritual, Social Emotional, Literacy, etc.)
12:30-1:00PM	<b>Classroom Time</b>   Clean-Up, Followed by Quiet Time and Bedtime Story Book
1-3PM	<b>Rest Time</b>
3-4PM	<b>Wake-Up, Bathroom, Snack and Large Group Time</b> Active Learning through Songs and Music, Stories, Rhymes, Fingerplays (* Literacy, Cognitive, Social Emotional, etc.)
4-6PM	<b>Playground/Playroom and Dismissal</b> (* Health & Physical Development)

This is a sample of a typical daily schedule for our full-time Threes Daycare classes.

Specialized classes are scheduled at various times and classroom schedules will change from day-to-day to accommodate specialized class times. Times are typically scheduled between 8:45am-12:30pm, and include Computer/Math Lab, Spanish, Fun & Fitness, Science Lab, Drama, and Multicultural Studies
